We will have some photos in a few weeks' time to show how the monies are being spent.

**Solemnity of the Epiphany:** Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany when God the Father reveals or manifests his Incarnate Son Jesus to the Magi. They bring with them gifts of Gold to signify Jesus's royalty, as Son of David and Incense to worship his Divinity as Son of God and Myrrh prophesying his suffering and death. As the Magi came from the East and outside of the Israelite land, they were Gentiles and non-Jews. This demonstrates that Jesus is Lord of all and Saviour of all and he comes to invite all peoples and all races into the Kingdom of God. We too are to bring Jesus to all and offer our life to his service. Pope Francis takes up the theme of Welcome for this, the World Day of Prayer for Justice and Peace "Migrants and Refugees" men and women in search of Peace. We should also make others feel Welcomed and at Peace.
